First Lesson 2 Kings 2:19-22 <u>19</u> Now the men of the city said to Elisha, "Behold, the situation of this city is pleasant, as my lord sees, but the water is bad, and the land is unfruitful."<u>20</u> He said, "Bring me a new bowl, and put salt in it." So they brought it to him.<u>21</u> Then he went to the spring of water and threw salt in it and said, "Thus says the LORD, I have healed this water; from now on neither death nor miscarriage shall come from it."<u>22</u> So the water has been healed to this day, according to the word that Elisha spoke.

<u>Second Lesson</u> 1 Peter 2:18-25 <u>18</u> Servants, be subject to your masters with all respect, not only to the good and gentle but also to the unjust. <u>19</u> For this is a gracious thing, when, mindful of God, one endures sorrows while suffering unjustly.<u>20</u> For what credit is it if, when you sin and are beaten for it, you endure? But if when you do good and suffer for it you endure, this is a gracious thing in the sight of God.<u>21</u> For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you might follow in his steps.<u>22</u> He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in his mouth.<u>23</u> When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten, but continued entrusting himself to him who judges justly.<u>24</u> He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.<u>25</u> For you were straying like sheep, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.

Gospel Mark 7:31-37 <u>31</u> Then he returned from the region of Tyre and went through Sidon to the Sea of Galilee, in the region of the Decapolis. <u>32</u> And they brought to him a man who was deaf and had a speech impediment, and they begged him to lay his hand on him.<u>33</u> And taking him aside from the crowd privately, he put his fingers into his ears, and after spitting touched his tongue.<u>34</u> And looking up to heaven, he sighed and said to him, "Ephphatha," that is, "Be opened."<u>35</u> And his ears were opened, his tongue was released, and he spoke plainly.

<u>36</u> And Jesus charged them to tell no one. But the more he charged them, the more zealously they proclaimed it.<u>37</u> And they were astonished beyond measure, saying, "He has done all things well. He even makes the deaf hear and the mute speak."


