Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors
August 18, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman, Kenneth Hertzog followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. Public Participation:

2. Bid Opening for 2021 Equipment Operators Contract:

- c. Roadmaster – Robert McConnell reported that the Township sent a letter to PennDOT requesting PennDOT to enact an Engine-Brake Retarder Prohibition From the intersection of SR 173 and Route 8 to 227 Centreville Pike.

The Township also requested that the residents would like to reduce the speed limit on SR 173 in Brady Township be reduced from 55 mph to 45 mph. The Township has not received a response from PennDOT as of this date.

- a. Shields Asphalt and Paving has completed the Asphalt Binder Course Project #2001-01.
- b. Holbein, Inc. has leveled the floor, installed the foam insulation, and placed the rebar in the new building. They are getting ready to pour the cement and put the pecks in the floor.
