## Questions About Common Core And The New Missouri Learning Standards?

In 2010, the Missouri State Board of Education adopted the Missouri Learning Standards, which align to both the Show-Me Standards and to the Common Core State Standards. Over the past two years, West Platte has been aligning our local curriculum to the Missouri Learning Standards, which will be assessed for the first time in April, 2015. The first goal of Missouri's Top 10 by 20 Campaign is ensuring all Missouri students graduate from High School being prepared for career and college. The Missouri Learning Standards were aligned to help students reach that goal.

The Missouri Learning Standards include the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) for English Language Arts and Math. The standards state what Missouri students are expected to know and be able to do at each grade level.
