

Job Title: **MECHANIC I**

WAGES

(hourly), based on qualifications

GENERAL

Performs work in the repair and maintenance of vehicles, equipment, and facilities in the District. Work involves performing preventative maintenance, routine maintenance, repair work, and maintaining logs.

This position reports to the Building & Grounds Supervisor.

SPECIFIC DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work involves welding, and building trades.
- Performs small and large engine repairs.
- Performs preventative and routine maintenance as scheduled.
- Performs repair work as necessary.
- Maintains logs and records of preventative maintenance, routine maintenance, repair maintenance, and parts consumed.
- Performs maintenance of facility grounds.
- Performs maintenance of facility buildings.
- Performs herbicide and pesticide spraying as requested, with non-restricted pesticides.
- Assist other work crews as requested in various District construction and repair work.

May be assigned to shift work. May be required to work weekends and holidays.

The duties listed above are illustrative only and are not intended to describe every function that may be performed by this employee. The omission of specific duties does not preclude management from assigning those duties.

EMERGENCY STATUS

Essential (level 2): Employee is likely to be required to work immediately following an emergency (declared or undeclared). Position does not include non-deferrable services. Employee is expected to have made personal arrangements to report to work.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

HS Diploma or equivalent

Valid FL Drivers License, class E minimum

3 years vehicle maintenance (preference given for heavy equipment maintenance) or equivalent combination of training and experience. Maximum of 2 years credit for training.
