One little girl's eyes really lit up when she saw the fun cover of "Mama Harris' Fried Pie Army" and she proudly carried off the book. We will be distributing every Monday through August 19.

Next Food Packing day will be July 7 or July 14 after 11 o'clock Worship. We need a Life Group to volunteer to pack. It goes pretty fast and bags are counted into totes for transportation downstairs on Mondays, one tote each week. 200 items will be due on or around July 1, from participating Life Groups. We are checking out some used book stores on line and in larger cities to find more of these types. This will take some funds and we do need some financial contributions. 
Fall Dinner Groups


