(December 7, 1914 - September 23, 2010)

 Werner Clabuesch age 95, of Pigeon died Thursday morning, September 23, at Country Gardens, Pigeon. He was born December 7, 1914 in Pigeon to the late Frederick J. and Hulda (Beyer) Clabuesch. Werner was a graduate of the Pigeon High School, Class of 1933, the Bay City Junior College, 1935 and the University of Michigan Law School receiving his degree in 1939.
