17th Century Re-Enactment

To include cannon-fire demonstration

On Sunday, Sept. 17th, the Isaak Walton League of York will host 17th Century re-enactors, the Twisted Knot Company of Pike and Shotte. As part of their demonstration the company will fire their cannon, a type used by Maryland colonists against the Susquehannock Indians and foreign colonial forces.



The Company portrays soldiers who used "pike and shot" tactics during the reign of Queen Elizabeth I, the early American Colonial period, and the English Civil Wars. They will be appearing at the Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire throughout October and asked the IWL for space to rehearse after their summer hiatus. Their demonstration will include matchlock muskets, pikes (two-handed spears) and classical sword fighting technique.

"The IWL's emphasis is on the outdoors," says Don Hollway, a member of both organizations, "and the TKC's is about history, but here their interests coincide. This event will appeal to history buffs, especially fans of black powder."

The demonstrations will be conducted in authentic period dress, including armor. The event will begin around 1PM and last until 4PM. Visitors will be welcome to ask guestions, handle the weaponry, and interact with the company. The event is open to the public.


