PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE —Waskah Whelan

Attention! Message from the President!

Our San Diego politicians want to impose a massive new MILEAGE TAX on every mile your drive!

Eighteen Chambers of Commerce across the County have formed the San Diego Business Coalition to spotlight the new exorbitant tax policies proposed by SANDAG. Drivers will pay \$800 more per year to drive on roads they already paid for with original gas and sales taxes.







\$0.04-\$0.06 per mile

\$0.80 per gallon tax

\$800 more per year per car

The Mileage Tax would be determined by a device installed in every vehicle, a tracking app on cell phones, or a yearly inspection of your odometer. This mileage Tax would cost tax payers over \$27 billion, all without a vote of the people.

SANDAG hopes to force an 11% increase in mass transit use with this punitive taxes on drivers. SANDAG installed bike lanes, removed parking spaces and cut down the number of traffic lanes on many streets all to force people onto buses and trolleys. It didn't work because mass transit doesn't go where the public needs to go and there is no security for passengers, especially after dark. This is risky for seniors and women alone as they are frequently target of thieves. Make that masked thieves since you can't ride a bus without a mask.

Two things you can do about this money grab from SANDAG's Vehicle Mileage Tax (VMT)

Then tell them you object to this tax and they were elected to serve the people. People do not want to pay \$800 per year extra to drive their own car to work.

2. On Nov 2, there is to be an election to fill a vacancy on the La Mesa City Council the outcome of this race will have a HUGE IMPACT on whether the Mileage Tax will be approved county-wide.


