

2019 ELIQG Challenge

Make a Butterfly Quilt

This year your challenge is to make butterfly themed quilt. It can be pieced, appliqued, or another technique such as a crazy quilt or whole cloth. The quilt must contain recognizable butterflies – either pieced, qpliqued, embroidered or prominently visible in either the quilting pattern or the fabric choices.

The quilt should be 20 inches by 20 inches, and consist of 3 layers: a top, a back and batting. It can be any technique of your choice, but must be primarily fabric . It can be quilted or tied. Be sure to check the “challenge quilt” box on the registration form.
