Class Rules:

For Structured Practice Classes: Horses and riders must show in legal NRCHA or AQHA equipment. All classes will be run like approved classes. Herd-work: Corner help with a 3-minute limit and a limit of 3 cows worked. Reining: no set pattern with a 5-minute limit. Boxing: 1½ or 2½ minutes from time gate closes. Fence Runs: 2½ minutes from time gate closes. Classes will be monitored. Whistle or horn will be blown at end of time. Excessive training will not be allowed.

Entry Form: Fill out your entry form and banquet reservation by **6:00 pm on January 24th, 2020**. Once you have filled the form, just hit the Green Submit arrow at top of form and it will be e-mailed to the CRCA. You will receive an e-mail confirming receipt of form within 24 hours. These practice sessions will be drawn like a regular approved NRCHA class. We will set draw times at the show once we have a better idea of how many riders/horses are coming.
