When: Saturday February 27, 2012 – 9 AM – 2 PM ish

Where: At the grounds of MCSA.

Details: We have begun to clean up the wooded area to the right (east) of the driveway as you approach the club. This has been disregarded for at least 20 years, and is filled with down branches, brush, landscape debris and some dead or poor quality trees. On January 24th, the MCSA chain saw crew cut up much of the downed wood and 10 trees. Now that effort needs to be supplemented with additional effort to get the area cleaned up. We will be working on the following:

- 1. Removal of cut up logs to fire pit or wood splitting area.**
- 2. Mulching of brush and limbs utilizing Chipper. (To be confirmed with Steve).**
- 3. Felling and clean up of a couple trees as determined.**
- 4. Clean up driveway and adjacent grounds.**
- 5. Wood splitting if I can arrange for a splitter to be there, for wood resale.**
- 6. Construction of conservation project to install “ Brush pile “ per PGC guidelines. They are great cover for rabbits and other small animals.**

The area we are clearing will be considered for replanting of hardwoods, Memorial Trees, wildlife shrubs, etc. If you are interested to work with the planting, please contact the clubhouse at the following number 717-393-6416.
