EQUITATION DIVISIONS

To be judged on position, performance, control of mount and correct style.

Leadline - Riders 7 yrs and under. May not cross enter into any other classes. Ties for Champion or Reserve will go to the rider with the most points in the WT class.

Walk-Trot - Open to junior and amateur riders of any age. May cross enter into Beginner Rider as eligible.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Riders 10 yrs and under. Judged on the rider. To show over crossrails.

Beginner Rider Equitation - Open to anyone in their first or second year of showing. To show over crossrails. Trotting anywhere on course permitted.

Junior Equitation - Open to junior riders only. Fences 2' for ponies, 2'6" for horses. **Brass Ring Devon Invitational Medal** - Open to both juniors and adults. Two equitation tests built into the first round, open scoring. Top 8 ribbon winners will be invited to compete in a qualifier only class at the Brass Ring Horse Show at Devon on July 13-14, 2024. Ponies 2', horses 2'6". Class will be split if entries warrant.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

To be judged on performance, manners and way of going.

Short Stirrup Hunter - Riders 10 yrs and under. To show over a course of simple verticals 18", no oxers.

Modified Hunter - Open to all junior and amateur riders. Fences 2'.

Low Children's Hunter Pony - Open to Junior riders on ponies. All ponies jump 2'. May not cross enter into the Children's Hunter.

Low Children's Hunter Horse - Open to Junior riders on horses. Fences 2'6". May not cross enter into Children's Hunter.

Low Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. Fences 2'6". May not cross enter into Adult Amateur Hunter.

Children's Hunter - Open to junior riders. May not cross enter into Pre-Children's Hunter. Horses 3', Large ponies 2'6", Small/Medium ponies 2'.

Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. All to jump 2'9". May not cross enter into Low Adult Amateur Hunter.

Developing Hunter - Open to all horses and ponies starting training in the hunter division. Trotting anywhere on course permitted. To jump crossrails.

Baby Green Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing, who have not shown over fences 2'9" or higher. Section A: 2', Section B: 2'6". Simple changes not to be penalized.

Thoroughbred Hunter - Open to any registered and non-registered thoroughbreds, all riders. Fences 2'3".

PLEASURE DIVISIONS

Judged on manners, suitability, performance and kindness.

Pleasure Pony - Open to all riders on ponies. Walk Trot, Walk-Trot-Canter, and to jump 18"-2'.

Pleasure Horse - Open to all riders on horses. Walk-Trot, Walk-Trot-Canter, and to jump 2'6".
