4. Old Business

The Commissioners were reminded to check and clear their mailboxes each month.

At this time during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Chief, President and Vice-President were reminded to practice all safety and PPE protocols.

4. Old Business continued

Mykola Myronowskyj reported that the 2021 generator maintenance contract renewal was received, however was another change that needed to be made to the contract. Mr. Myronowskyj contacted GenServe and the corrections were made. The contract was signed and will be sent to GenServe. The check for the contract payment of \$835.00 will be sent in January 2021.

Mykola Myronowskyj is still currently working on the 2020 Forest Grove equipment audit.

The MUA's for the surrounding locals will need to be updated. Mykola Myronowskyj is currently working on them and will submit them to the Board for review and approval once they have been finalized.

A safe was purchased and is now in use in the Commissioners office. Andrew Bellone Jr. suggested the Board purchase a fireproof safe to store the important documents that the Board of Fire Commissioners possess. The documents that were stored in the Fire Department safe have been moved to the Commissioners safe.

The Board of Fire Commissioners 2019 financial audit is now completed and the audit payment was sent to Ball, Buckley & Seher, LLP.

5. New Business

The VFIS renewal questionnaire was completed and the Board reviewed the package. Mykola Myronowskyj will send the completed questionnaire to Glenn Insurance.

A blue light permit for Gerald Sheridan, Andrew Bellone Jr, signed the permit, a copy was made for the file and the packet will be given to the Chief to complete.

The bookkeeper is currently working to rectify the discrepancy that was found on the balance sheet regarding the total fixed assets. Apparently, a simple journal entry was made in the accounting software. This was the incorrect type of entry and we are working to have the figure corrected to reflect the proper total fixed assets as represented on the audits.

The 2003 Ford Excursion may be at its end of life. In addition to the costly repairs needed to the body and frame, the Chief reported that the fuel system is having issues. Mykola Myronowskyj suggested to the Board that we have the Chief obtain estimates to fully repair the vehicle to be operational before any repairs are made. The Chief has until the nest meeting to obtain the needed estimated. At the next meeting the Board will review the costs and determine if the vehicle should be repaired or if it is financially responsible to take it out of service.
