# Tarp A Frame



## POSITIVES:

- PLENTY OF SPACE TO SLEEP 2 OR MORE PEOPLE
- EASY FAST SETUP
- GREAT DURING HEAVY RAINFALL

## NEGATIVES:

- NO GROUND SHEET
- STILL LIMITED HEADROOM

# Wedge Tarp

## Advantages:

- Relatively quick set up
- No past experience needed

## Disadvantages:

- Limited space
- Open side





# Tarp Shelter

## Advantages:

- Relatively quick set up
- No past experience needed
- Can use fire for warmth

## Disadvantages:

- Not protected well from elements
- Need ridgeline and trees nearby



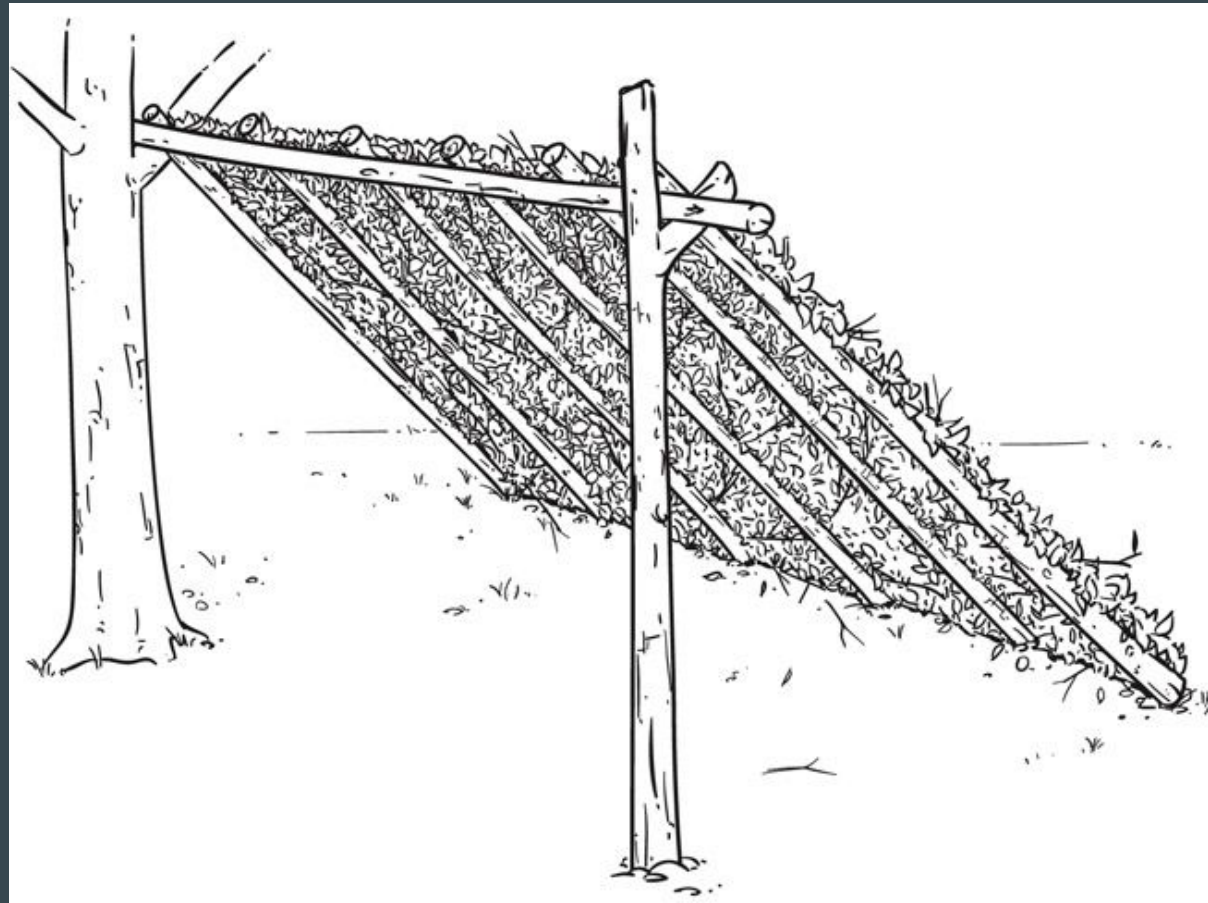
# Lean-To

## Advantages:

- Can use fire for warmth
- Use natural materials
- Does not require lots of skill

## Disadvantages:

- Set up time





# A-Frame

## Advantages:

- Great insulation
- Protection from rain

## Disadvantages:

- Set up time
- No Fire
- Need a lot of Materials
- Single person
- Very little living space





# Debris Shelter

## Advantages:

- Not as hard to make
- Can provide more room
- Don't need to spend as much time gathering the right materials (use what you have)

## Disadvantages:

- Set up time
- No Fire
- Lot of materials needed



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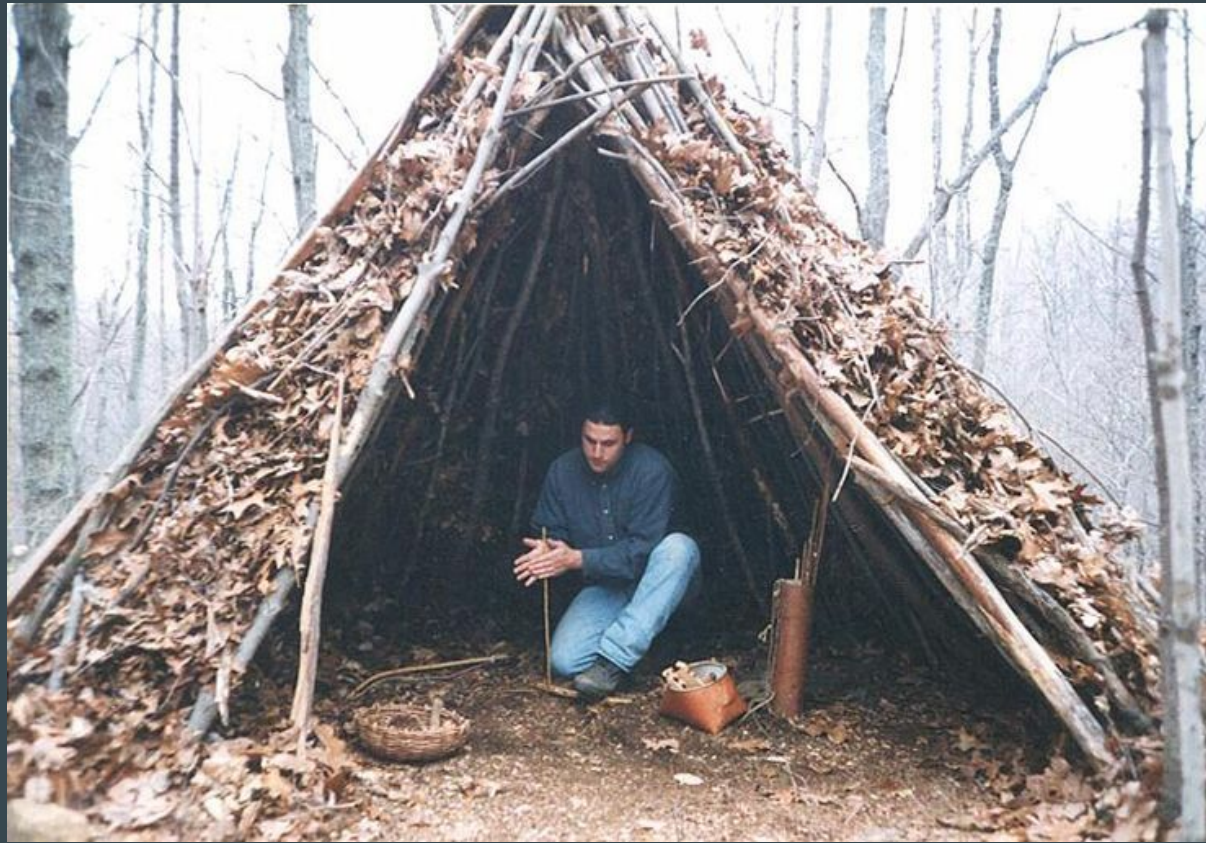
# TeePee

## Advantages:

- Fire inside shelter
- Long Term
- Can support a few people

## Disadvantages:

- Set up time
- Practice required
- Lose headroom





# No Shelter

## Advantages:

- No Setup Required
- Sleep as many as needed
- Any environment
- No skill needed

## Disadvantages:

- No protection from the elements
