 - Change "affiliate" terminology to "chapter"
 - Allocation of Delegates
 - Cap at 275 delegates
 - Every active state receives 2
 - Remaining delegates allocated on the following:
 - 51% determined from the percent of national life members
 - 49% determined from the percent of national active alumni chapters
 - Extend PNO term to 3 years and add 3rd PNO position
 - President-elect candidates = any council member that has served at least 1 year (Regional VP's, Org. Reps, PNO's)
