

AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO

Ordinance: O-2013-44

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND UPGRADE OF TWO NEW VEHICLES
FOR USE BY THE AMELIA POLICE DEPARTMENT AND SAFETY SERVICES
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has reported to the Mayor and Village Council that, due to the age and condition of the police vehicles currently in use by the Amelia Village Police Department, the Police Department is in need of a new police vehicle to efficiently and effectively perform its assigned duties;

WHEREAS, Safety Services is also in need of a new vehicle to efficiently and effectively perform its assigned duties;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained, by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio; that:

SECTION I This Council finds that it will be in the best interest of Amelia Village, Ohio to enter into a purchase agreement to acquire two new vehicles, one for the Police Department and one for Safety Services to enable the departments to better perform their assigned duties.

SECTION II Council further finds that the required vehicles can be purchased through the State of Ohio without being submitted for public bid.

SECTION III Council authorizes and directs the Mayor and Fiscal Officer of the Village to enter into an Agreement to purchase two Ford Explorers from Lebanon Ford, a dealer authorized to sell vehicles under the state procurement process, for the price of Twenty Five Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Four dollars and zero cents (\$25,944.00) each for a total cost of Fifty One Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Eight dollars and zero cents (\$51,888.00).

SECTION IV Council authorizes and directs the Mayor and Fiscal Officer of the Village to enter into an agreement with Camp Safety Equipment for the installation of additional police vehicle equipment on one of the vehicles for a cost of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-Two dollars and seventeen cents (\$7,522.17), as shown on the attached quote.

SECTION V Council authorizes and directs the Mayor and Fiscal Officer of the Village to enter into an agreement with A&A Safety for the installation of additional safety service vehicle equipment on the other vehicle for a cost of Two Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Nine dollars and sixty-five cents (\$2,269.65), as shown on the attached quote.

SECTION VI Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

SECTION VII That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to approve this at the earliest possible time, in order for the police department and safety services to effectively and efficiently perform the duties and obligations imposed by law. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

DERRICK CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.
