State of Illinois Fire Service Institute Modules I and II OR National Fire Academy (80 hours) Fire/Arson Investigator course OR Forty hours Advance Department of Law Enforcement Fire/Arson Investigator course OR State of Illinois Fire Service Institute Module III OR National Fire Academy (40 hours) Advance Fire/Arson Investigator course OR Other 240-hour State Arson Investigator course OR Education, Experience or Training considered equivalent by the General Board.

The SPECIALTIES section is where you would indicate whether the investigator is a Photographer, Evidence Technician, Lab Specialist, etc.

SCHOOLS/SEMINARS - These are specific courses pertaining to the field of fire and arson investigation. Related courses are those courses that add additional support to the investigative field, (interview, interrogation, photography, evidence collection, etc.). Upon successful completion of the course, the student will receive a certificate of completion.

CERTIFICATIONS - Awarded to persons in recognition of their successful completion of requisite courses in fire science, investigation techniques and support systems. Personnel must have demonstrated their knowledge and abilities in the Investigative field. A document is then presented recognizing them as certified in their particular field of expertise.
