



## January 18, 2021 – COVID Update

Greetings Midway Residents, Families, Friends & Staff!

There are no new COVID positive residents or staff. One unit remains of precautionary quarantine until January 21<sup>st</sup>. All residents and staff remain asymptomatic.

CVS Health has confirmed their second COVID vaccine clinic for Wednesday, January 20<sup>th</sup>. This clinic will administer second doses for those who previously received the first dose. They will also administer first doses to those residents and staff who wish to receive the vaccine's two dose series. This is the final opportunity to receive the vaccine series at Midway Nursing Home.

After this second clinic, except for second doses to be administered, doses that were previously allocated for Midway NH will be allocated elsewhere. The third and final CVS Health clinic will only administer second doses.

If you have not already consented to the vaccine series, we urge you to consider it now as there will not be any further vaccination at the facility after CVS Health clinics conclude. Please contact a facility RN by noon on Tuesday, January 19<sup>th</sup> if you wish to take the vaccine at Midway NH. As you may have heard in the media, doses available at community clinics are changing daily and future allocation of vaccine is unknown.
