1. State meeting rescheduled for the 16<sup>th</sup> of March

2. Yakima is the new community FYSPRT. Yakima had about 20 people at their meeting. Comprehensive hosted the meeting. Jeannet Barnes presented about their history
3. Introduced Teresa Malley from the Children's Administration. Brought information about what DSHS can provide and went through a through explanation of the CPS division and the pathways that are used to investigate allegation of child abuse or neglect. Some information that was given included a Parent's Guide to CPS and brochures about Family Reconciliation Services and Family Assessment Response. This information can be found online.

#### Open Forum to Discuss Supporting Walla Walla by Robyn Herald

3. Mike Roberts opened the forum and there was discussion of recent trainings that were provided to the middle schools and high schools. 75 student leaders were trained as well as parents. Networks for Life had a 3 hour training at the ESD
4. Jill Mulhausen led the group to share ideas after they finished with the worksheet. Some ideas on how to help included reaching out to family members, trainings on resources and looking out for warning signs, medication awareness and gun safety, destigmatizing suicide, and writing support letters to the schools and individuals affected.

6. Mike Roberts is meeting with the Walla Walla Suicide Prevention Coalition
