- Beth Kennett's mother-in-law is at Peak Resources in Graham, recovering from a recent hospital stay

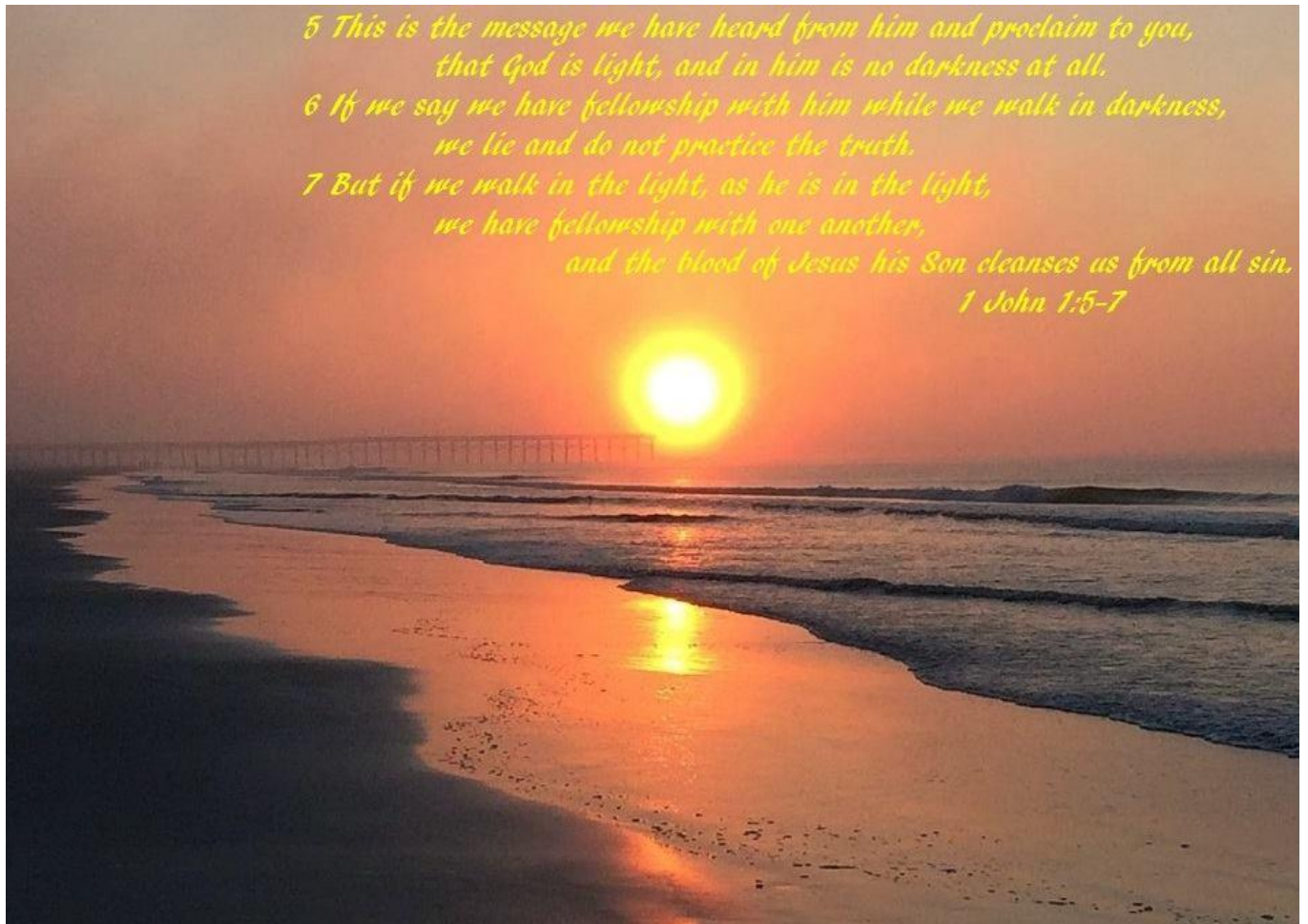
This Sunday's Scripture reading will be from Matthew 9:35 – 10:14 and Genesis 18-21.
