A few minor scratches, dings, and nicks here and there. Typical yellowing of the limbs. The sight window was tapped for a cushion button which is missing. However, it does come with a screw-in plastic flipper rest (see pic on last page). Factory tapped for a stabilizer. Clear flat satin finish. The decal is in good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
