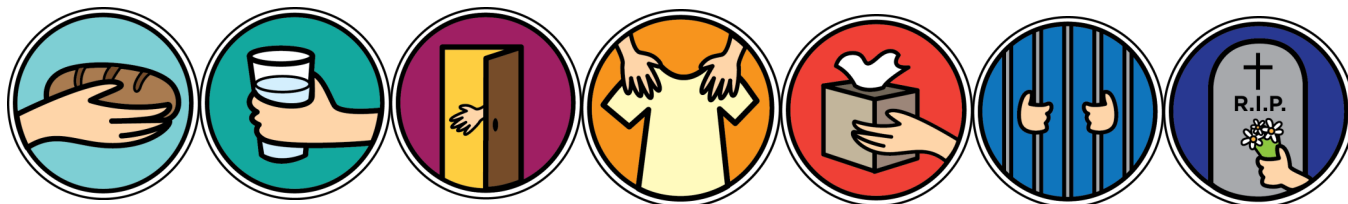

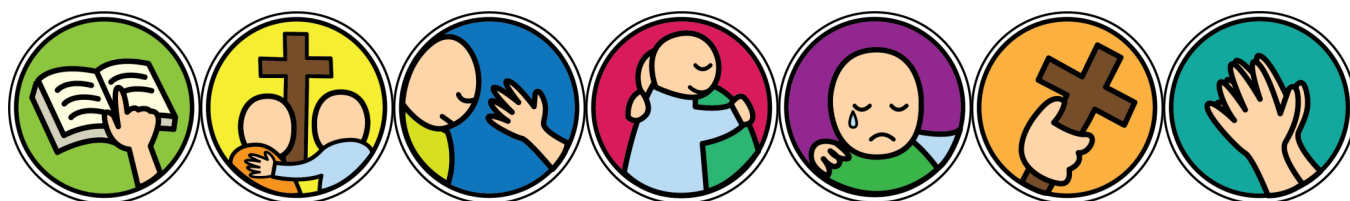


CORPORAL WORKS OF MERCY
