BELLS OF PEACE: A Remembrance of those who served in the First World War. Bells call us to wake, to pray, to work, to arms, to feast and, in times of crisis, to come together. On November 11, 1918, the ringing of church bells erupted spontaneously across the country, as an outpouring of relief that four years of war had come to an end. As per a request from The Royal Canadian Legion the St. Agatha Church bells will be tolled 100 times with 5 seconds between tolls - starting at the going down of the sun on **November 11, 2018**, at approximately 5:15pm.
