Fur classes [Judged immediately following the breed class; rabbit must have been entered in the breed class]: \$1.00/rabbit/show

No refund for rabbits scratched from class.

NOTE: all outstanding amounts owing to E.A.R.S. must be paid in full prior to individual or family entries being accepted. Cash, money order or e-transfer accepted. We are no longer able to accept payment by cheque.

YOUTH [under 19 yrs] SHOW fee: \$3.00/rabbit

Because the Youth Show is non-sanctioned, rabbits showing in Youth MAY be entered in both Youth and Open Shows on Sunday.

Youth must carry their own rabbit to the show table. Adult supervision is encouraged to ensure safety to both the youth exhibitor and the rabbit. Assistance to the smaller youth exhibitor to lift the rabbit onto the show table or into the show coop is permissable.

Registrar: Stephen Hultholm will be available to register your rabbits Friday between noon and 5 p.m. You must present a valid A.R.B.A. membership card.

Ensure you have a printed pedigree with three generations, all weights, ear numbers and any registration numbers must be included. The breeder's name and address is required if the rabbit was purchased.



Copies of computer generated pedigrees with all the necessary information speed up the registration process.

The cost is \$8.00 per rabbit payable in cash at the time of rabbit registration.

- Sanctioned Breeds: All sanctioned breeds will be posted on the website and in the show room.
- Check in Friday: Exhibitors must check in and pay entries between 11 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- **Saturday:** Judging starts at **1100 hrs**. Best In Show, Reserve In Show and Best of Best Opposite presentations for each show begins at 7 p.m.
- **Sunday:** Judging starts at **1100 hrs.** Best In Show, Reserve In Show and Best of Best Opposite presentations for each show begins at 6 p.m.
- Check Out Sunday: Due to this show being a K-Days event, open to the public, exhibitors and entries must remain until 7 p.m.
- After Show Arrangements: Exhibitors may leave their rabbits in the travel carriers after the show in a secure location so they can attend K-Days events. Owners/exhibitors must provide appropriate care, food and water for their rabbits during this time.

If you are travelling a large distance, please check with the Show Superintendent for early release.

- Vendors: Anyone displaying and/or actively selling rabbits or rabbit supplies are considered Vendors. Vendors must be approved by EARS and Northlands Park. Contact earsentries@yahoo.ca to make arrangements. Reminder that rabbits are NOT to be sold at this event.
- Venue & Directions: Directions, building, unloading and parking information will be forwarded to you with your exhibitor's sheet following your registration. Remember to use the new e-mail address: EarsRabbitShows@hotmail.com

In accordance with health regulations, no animals are permitted in the concession, lobby or bathroom areas. Violators may be asked to leave the premises and entries will be forfeited.

Do not block fire exits.

No alcohol is permitted on the premises.

No dogs (except service dogs) are allowed in the building.

Rabbit sales in the parking lots are not permitted.

This is a COOP show. Your rabbit must be housed in the coop designated for your rabbit. Rabbits will be grouped in the showroom according to breed, not according to exhibitor.

Bring your own dishes [NO bottles], feed and show supplies. You are responsible for the care of your rabbit and the cleaning of the coop on a regular basis so that it is always clean and presentable to the public. Shavings will be provided.



Show Rules

- All exhibitors must sign-in, confirm their exhibitor reports are correct and have their entries paid in full before the commencement of the show. There shall be No Refunds for scratched entries after entries are submitted.
- All rabbits coming into the show grounds must be pre-entered in the show. There are no accommodations for rabbits not entered.
- All substitutions must be presented to the Show Secretary and will be allowed until 1 hour prior to the show commencing. Substitutions MUST be the same breed/sex/age with the tattoo being the only variation in the entry (this is referred to as an Ear # change for a \$1 fee per rabbit per show). All other changes will be \$5 per rabbit per show.
- Fur classes will be judged immediately following the breed class; rabbit must have been entered in the breed class. Rabbits are not eligible for this class if they were DQ'd in the preceding breed class.
- Entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor and entered under their name and not in the Rabbitry name. Entry forms must state proper name of breed, colour/variety, class, sex and tattoo # of each animal. Incomplete or illegible entry forms will not be accepted. Please read entry form carefully. The Show Secretary is not responsible for errors made due to illegible entry form.
- No exhibitor shall alter class sheets in any way. Any changes to the class sheets made by anyone but the **Show Secretary** or approved committee member will be considered void/disqualified, and not eligible for awards or points.
- All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed in the left ear. Rabbits deemed not to have a legible/permanent tattoo will be disqualified. **Marker/pen is not acceptable**. Exception for the Commercial Buck and Doe classes (if offered).
- All exhibitors are responsible for getting their animals to and from the show table before judging of class begins. If you are leaving the judging area, you must make arrangements to have appropriate rabbits taken to the judging table or you forfeit your entry in that class.
- Only Judges, Show Superintendent, Show Secretary and <u>pre-assigned</u> clerks are allowed behind the judging table at any time. No exhibitors.
- E.A.R.S. Show Superintendent/Show Committee reserves the right to reject any rabbits suffering from disease or displayed in an unfit or in unclean condition and may be subject to a health inspection prior to and or after judging has commenced. Animals not adhering to health standards outlined by Show Superintendent/Show Committee must be removed from the building.
- The American Rabbit Breeders Association host club reserves the right to refuse entries from exhibitors placing an entry from all locations within 150 miles which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCV/RHD/VHD within the past 60 days of the entry deadline.
- NO 'FOR SALE' SIGNS or active selling of rabbits is PERMITTED. Exchanging stock with fellow exhibitors is permissible, but no selling rabbits onsite to the public. Bring your business cards. All rabbits coming into the show grounds must be entered in the show.
- Prizes will not be mailed out if you are not present to accept them.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to bring zip ties or cage locks as an extra precaution. E.A.R.S. will not be held responsible for any accident, theft, or vandalism. However, every precaution will be taken to prevent any of these occurrences.
- The current edition of the ARBA Standard of Perfection will be the guide to all breeds.
- Exhibitors need not be members of E.A.R.S. or the ARBA to enter in sanctioned shows.
- **** The Show Superintendent/Show Committee shall decide on any point not covered in the show rules.****



Commercial Classes - Friday evening Non-ARBA Sanctioned

All rabbits must have a legible tattoo and be entered in their appropriate breed/age class in the Open Shows on Saturday and/or Sunday. This is an extra competition focusing on commercial aspects. The following is a very brief description of each class excerpted from the A.R.B.A. Standards. It is highly recommended you purchase the 2016-2020 A.R.B.A. Standards of Perfection for your reference. (pages 36-38) All A.R.B.A. General Disqualifications from Competition and Breed Disqualifications from Competition apply to all classes; see additional notes in class. All rabbits are weighed in the presence of the judge. Single Fryers Judged on: (1) meat type 45 pts, (2) condition of flesh 35 pts, and (3) fur 20 pts. Age limit: not over 10 weeks of age Minimum weight: 3.5 lbs Maximum weight: 5.5 lbs Single Fryers may show in the meat pens class. Disqualifications from Competition: Exceptions include body smut on Californian or Himalayan marked animals. NOTE: bucks must show both or neither testicle. Judged on: (1) meat type 40 pts, (2) condition of flesh 30 pts, (3) uniformity of body and weight 20 Meat Pens pts, and (4) fur 10 pts. 3 rabbits – same breed, same variety (e.g. Breed = New Zealand; Variety = black, broken, red, or white) Uniformity of meat pen is important; though the meat pen does not have to be from the same litter. **note which animals are to be together in the meat pen class** Age & weight limits are the same as Single Fryers. Disqualifications from Competition: refer to Single Fryers If any one rabbit in the pen is disqualified from competition, the entire pen becomes disqualified. Roasters Judged on: (1) meat type 35 pts, (2) condition of flesh 35 pts, and (3) fur 30 pts. Age limit: Must be under 6 months of age Minimum weight: over 5.5 lbs Maximum weight: 9 lbs Stewers ... Judged on: (1) meat type 35 pts, (2) condition of flesh 35 pts, and (3) fur 30 pts.
