What is Advent? Advent is the first season of the Christian year, the 4 Sundays leading up to Christ's birth. Advent means "coming". During the season of Advent Christians reflect on Christ's first coming to earth in the manger, but more importantly focus on preparation and waiting for Christ to come again. According to Scripture, that won't be the calm, silent scene described in Christmas carols.

In 1928, Dietrich Bonhoeffer preached: "It is very remarkable that we face the thought that God is coming so calmly, whereas previously peoples trembled at the day of God We have become so accustomed to the idea of divine love and of God's coming at Christmas that we no longer feel the shiver of fear that God's coming should arouse in us. We ... [forget] the serious aspect, that the God of the world draws near to the people of our little earth and lays claim to us." God is love; we'll be in good hands at the end of time. But during Advent, also be in awe of God. Embrace a reverent fear of the Lord that reminds you how profound it is that God chooses again and again to draw near and lay claim to you.

Daniel Ralph Fondell was born February 3, 1953 in Williamson, WV to Ralph and Gertrude (Franklin) Fondell. He moved to Alaska with his family in 1959, graduating from Nome High School in 1971 and from North Park College in Chicago in 1975



with a degree in classical philology. Dan married Luanne Anderson on November 29, 1980 at Sioux Falls, SD. Dan and Luanne made their home in Nome and then Anchorage, AK, where he served as CEO of Bering Straits Native Corporation. They moved their family to Dawson, MN, in 1991, where Dan owned Wickersham Antiques, and later TAC Computers. Dan put down roots in Dawson, serving in leadership roles at Johnson Memorial Hospital, Dawson Covenant Church, and Milan Village Arts School. In addition to his lifelong interest in history and antiques, he found a skill and passion for craftsmanship while in Dawson, developing his identity as a jewelry maker, artisan baker, silversmith, and steadfast supporter of the arts.

His family was his greatest joy. He is survived by his wife, Luanne; three children: Nathaniel (Ellen) Fondell of Richfield, MN; Elisabeth Fondell of Dawson, MN; and Jonathan Fondell of Minneapolis, MN; three grandchildren: Everly, Oskar, and Arlo; his parents: Ralph and Gertrude Fondell of Chugiak, AK; his siblings: Kathryn (James) Congdon of Manley, AK; Rebecca (Wayne) Carlson of Algonquin, IL; Stephen (Lynne) Fondell of Jenks, OK; and John (Truc Lien) Fondell of Eagle River, AK; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Preceding him in death were his grandparents: Nathaniel & Lillian Franklin and Clarence & Selma Fondell and an infant brother.






DAWSON COVENANT CHOIR
