



Pyramid Building Receives Energy Star Rating by Tom Lasater

Congratulations to SAABE member and Operating Engineer Howard Newsome for achieving an Energy Star rating for the building he maintains, the Pyramid Building! (Howard works for Endura Advisory Group.)

An Energy Star audit stated that the building, which was built in 1978, could not qualify for an Energy Star rating, but that didn't deter Howard! He began by installing water conserving faucet aerators, shower heads and toilets. Then, the water from cooling coil condensation was piped to the cooling towers which resulted in a 50% savings in water and a reduction in the amount of cooling tower chemicals used. And, by using drip irrigation for about 90% of the property, the lawn irrigation was controlled.

Lighting conservation was next. Timers were used on hallway and perimeter lights, and parking garage lights were staggered. Lighting sensors were installed on five floors of the building which resulted in a savings of 33,000 kw per hour with a six month payback.

Howard determined that, based on the expenses for the other areas, the payback would be within a year to a year and a half.

Steve Seymour with Blackmon Mooring gave a superb presentation on "Disaster Recovery."

He explained the methods used in the restoration of multiple products from electronics to various types of building materials to documents and other paper materials.

Steve also explained the different methods for drying a structure which has been flooded. Refrigeration-based air dryers and desiccant wheel systems are both very effective methods for certain applications.

He also advised everyone to freeze any documents, files or books which have become saturated with water in order to minimize the risk of biological growth. This will also minimize the damage to the paper and printing contained in the affected files, books and papers.

In all, it was a very informative presentation and had everyone's attention throughout!
