



St. Mary's Sunshine Center Summer Camp Program 2020



St. Mary's Sunshine Center will be offering themed camps filled with fun and adventure. Each session is full of hands-on activities that focus on different interests. Most weeks have field trips and/or guest speakers to add even more excitement.

Week 1: 6/22-6/26 Dig it! -Camper will get a little dirty, while having a lot of fun with a week of exploring different plants and seeds. They will test their own theories on helping plants grow. They will look at plant parts under a microscope. Campers will plant and take care of a garden. They will also taste a variety of edible plants and seeds.

Week 2: 6/29-7/2 Party in the USA- Join us in celebrating the United States of America's 244th birthday with the ultimate weeklong blow out. Camper will be creating red, white and blue crafts, treats and games. Camper will learn about American Symbols; the bald eagle, American flag, the declaration of independence, and the statue of Liberty. Camper will discover what freedom means and celebrate America's diverse culture. Campers will build a patriotic float and to pull it in a mini parade.

Week 3: 7/6-7/10 Some Assembly Required-Camper will build simple robots and construct basic mechanisms that roll, shoot, and glide. Campers will come up with a design, follow plans, and use an assortment of different materials. Campers will work on problem solving skills and learn about cause and effect, as they test and retest their designs.

Week 4: 7/13-7/17 Happy Crafters- Campers will use their imaginations to turn an assortment of materials into handcrafted works of art. Camper's creativity will shine, through canvas painting, sculpture, textiles, weaving, jewelry making and much more! Camper will discover that Art is everywhere and there is no wrong way to do it.

Week 5: 7/20-7/24 Island Adventure- Campers will test their endurance by building a shelter, making a campfire, running obstacle courses and scavenger hunts. Campers will design and name their own island. Campers will end their week of adventures with a Luau celebration

Week 6: 7/27-7/31 Sunshine Olympics- Campers will examine the many different countries, sports and events that make up the Olympics. Campers will create their own Olympic event for everyone to try. While engaging in Olympic events campers will review good sportsmanship and teamwork.

Week 7: 8/3-8/7 Play with your food! - Campers will plan and prepare a variety of tasty treats. They will experiment with food science and molecular gastronomy. They will use their senses of sight and smell, to try and trick their taste buds. Campers will learn about making balanced and healthy food choices.

Week 8: 8/10-8/14 Go with the flow- Campers will investigate water in all its states of matter, the importance of water and what water does for use. Prepare to get wet as campers play water games and do water inspired activities. Water is a lot of fun to play in, but it can also be relaxing. Campers will listen to ocean sounds and learn techniques to help them relax and destress.

Week 9: 8/17-8/21 Pets Unleashed- Campers will explore different types of pets and service animals. Campers will look at the needs of pets and decide what they think is the best kind of pet. Campers will get some hands-on animals experience when Mr. Tom's Critter Cabin comes by for a visit.

Week 10: 8/24-8/28 Let the Games Begin! - Campers will enjoy an assortment of different games from classic board games like candy land to picnic games like egg spoon race to indoor games like musical chairs. Camper will create and play their own games including their own board game. Anyway you play, game time is fun time! On Thursday will be our end of summer carnival, with lots of games, a moon bounce and cotton candy.
