Richard Charles Schweitzer, 69 of Fair Haven Township, Bay Port, died Wednesday evening, April 22 in Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, following a lengthy illness.

Mr. Schweitzer was born near Bay Port on May 14, 1917, the son of Arthur and Minnie (Symons) Schweitzer. He served in the U.S. Air Force during World War II, and was employed at Industrial Brownhoist of Bay City and then Bay City Chevrolet for 10 years, retiring in 1982. He was also a farmer in the Bay Port area for many years. He was a member of Kilmanagh United Methodist Church.
