APPROVAL OF THE CONSENT AGENDA

Committeeman D. Hansen requested the removal of Correspondence #6 from the Consent Agenda for further discussion.

A MOTION was made by Committeeman K. Gourlay and seconded by Committeeman D. Hansen, with all members in favor, to approve the Consent Agenda with Correspondence #6 removed for further discussion.

Correspondence #6- Hampton Township Recreation Committee – January 25, 2017 Reorganization and Regular Meeting Minutes: Committeeman D. Hansen referred to the Hampton Township January 2017 Recreation Meeting Minutes, pg. 3, regarding the Little League State Tournament in July 2017 scheduled to be held at the Hampton Township Municipal Park.

Recreation Liaison Committeeman S. MacKenzie suggested participating in the community event by appropriating an amount of \$1,000.00 from the Recreation Budget.

Recreation Committee Chairperson S. Rude stated that the Recreation Committee discussed budgeting \$1,000.00 to operate the Township Pavilion during the Tournament. Committeeman D. Hansen agreed that a \$1,000.00 appropriation would be a reasonable amount to purchase supplies.

A MOTION was made by Committeeman D. Hansen and seconded by Committeeman S. MacKenzie, with all members in favor, to approve a \$1,000.00 appropriation from the Recreation Budget to operate the Township Pavilion during the week of the Little League State Tournament.

A MOTION was made by Committeeman D. Hansen and seconded by Committeeman S. MacKenzie, with all members in favor, to approve the January 25, 2017 Recreation Minutes, as listed on the Consent Agenda.

REGULAR AGENDA

ORDINANCES

Based on the proposed introduced budget, Township Administrator E. Klose stated that the average assessed homeowner in Hampton Township would experience a municipal tax increase of \$9.17 annually. She noted that the Hampton Township Board of Education would be meeting in the near future to discuss their 2017 Budget.

Township Administrator E. Klose stated that Hampton Township's surplus is very robust at \$1.8 million, as of December 31, 2016.

RESOLUTIONS

**HAMPTON TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE SUBMISSION OF
THE RECYCLING TONNAGE GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NEW JERSEY
DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION**

WHEREAS, The Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grants may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, It is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue to expand existing programs, and

WHEREAS, The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection is promulgating recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

WHEREAS, The recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

WHEREAS, A Resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for such tonnage grants will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of Hampton Township to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

WHEREAS, Such a Resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is properly completed and timely filed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hampton that Hampton Township hereby endorses the submission of the recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates Karen Hansen to ensure that the application is properly filed, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies received from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust fund to be solely for the purpose of recycling.

**REVIEW OF PENDING 2017
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS ROAD PROJECTS AND
EQUIPMENT PURCHASE**

Township Administrator E. Klose recommended that township officials go out to bid for a new Dump Truck once the Hampton Township Annual 2017 Budget has been adopted, as previously discussed.

Township Administrator E. Klose stated that East Shore Drive and West Shore Drive are in need of upgrades.

Administrator E. Klose stated her intention to apply for a New Jersey Department of Transportation grant to complete the last phase of the Kemah-Mecca Lake Road Project. If the NJDOT approves the grant, she recommended completing Kemah-Mecca Lake Road and West Shore Drive. The East Shore Drive Paving Project could be postponed by placing it on the schedule for FY 2018.

A MOTION was made by Committeeman D. Hansen and seconded by Committeeman K. Gourlay, with all members in favor, to have Township Engineer Harold E. Pellow prepare estimates for the 2017 Department of Public Works Projects referenced above.

HAMPTON TOWNSHIP FIRE AND RESCUE UPDATE

HTVFR President B. Wehrenberg stated that the parking lot at Fire Station #2 needs to be repaved. He asked the Township Committee to consider including it in the Kemah-Mecca Road Paving Project. Administrator E. Klose responded that she would discuss the matter with the Township Engineer.

HTVFR Chief D. Gunderman reported that HTVFR volunteers responded to 28 EMS call and 37-fire calls year-to-date.

PUBLIC SESSION

Ms. Katie Rotondi was present to provide follow-up information concerning the possibility of artist painting a mural on the train trestle located on Newton-Swartzwood Road in an attempt to dissuade vandals from covering the area with graffiti. The idea was presented at a previous Township Committee Meeting in response to complaints from residents. Although township officials had the trestle cleaned and painted, the problem persists. Since that meeting, Ms. Rotondi has spoken with a Kittatinny Regional High School Official about having the seniors submit their ideas for murals to the Township Committee. She also contacted the Valley Arts in Orange, New Jersey. They indicated that similar programs have been implemented in their area with great success.

Committeeman S. MacKenzie stated that the Township Recreation Committee is considering participating in the cause and possibly making it a community event. He explained that the State owns the concrete trestle in conjunction with the New Jersey Rail Trail. Committeeman S. MacKenzie added that that Kittatinny State Park representatives are concerned about the graffiti and have expressed an interest in seeing the problem resolved.

Committeeman S. MacKenzie suggested that Ms. Rotondi speak with Township Recreation Committee Chairwoman S. Rude prior to leaving the meeting to discuss setting up a subcommittee regarding this issue. In the meantime, he would try to put together a coalition of Municipal, County, State Park, Rail Trail officials for the purpose of jointly addressing the problem.

Township Recreation Committee Member J. Cutler announced that he intends to resign from his position on the Recreation Committee after 23 years of service. Township officials thanked him for his service.

Mr. Cutler asked the Township Committee to consider recognizing Hampton Township resident, Harry Johnson, who passed away. He explained that Mr. Johnson was one of the instrumental people who helped organize the Hampton Township Playground Project. Mayor P. Yetter said the matter would be discussed further with the Recreation Committee.

Recreation Committee Chairwoman S. Rude asked for an update regarding a possible Hampton Township Summer Camp Program. Committeeman S. MacKenzie stated that he recently emailed the Recreation Committee information that Township Administrator E. Klose had compiled regarding this matter. He stated that would review it with S. Rude after the meeting.
