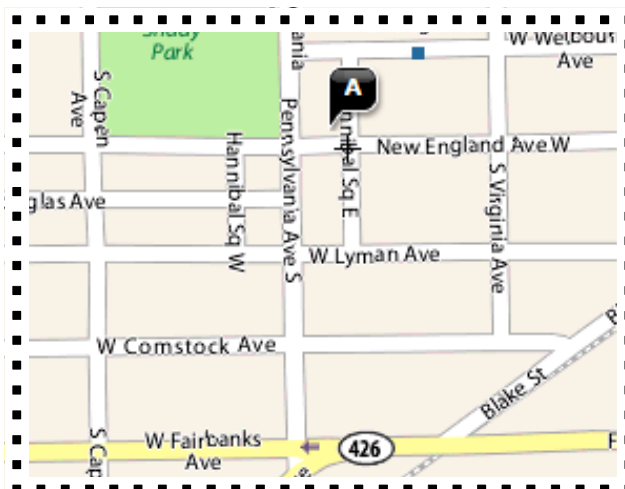

July 19- ALMOST HOME by Pam Jenoff (Passion, Romance, Thriller Perfect Summer Read!)

Review: The mystery in ALMOST HOME is thrilling and takes twists and turns galore. The reader never knows who to trust as one person after another falls under suspicion. It is an exciting enjoyable read. ALMOST HOME is highly recommended if you're in the mood for some light and fun reading. Be warned, this is a novel you're really going to want to read cover to cover, so be prepared to stay up late into the night.

About the Author: Pam Jenoff attended George Washington University in Washington, D.C., and Cambridge University in England. She became a Special Assistant to the Secretary of the Army which provided a unique opportunity to participate in operations at senior levels of government, including helping the families of the Pan Am Flight 103 victims secure their memorial at Arlington National Cemetery and recovery efforts at the site of the Oklahoma City bombing. In 1996 she was assigned to the U.S. Consulate in Krakow, Poland., to work on matters such as the preservation of Auschwitz and the restitution of Jewish property in Poland. Jenoff left the Foreign Service is now an attorney in Philadelphia.

August 16th- PLEASE LOOK AFTER MOM by Kyung-Sook Shin (An international best seller which penetrates the very essence of what it means to be a family) This is the story of a family splintered by the loss of matriarch So-nyo, an illiterate farm wife who vanishes in a packed Seoul subway station. The novel unspools from the viewpoints of her eldest daughter, her eldest son, her abusive husband, and, finally, So-nyo herself. The picture that emerges shows an unappreciated mother who sacrificed her life for her family. Shin's novel probes the emotional investment and selflessness of a woman who gives so much of herself that she's nearly obliterated. PLEASE LOOK AFTER MOM is the story of South Korea's sometimes painful transition from an agrarian, war-torn nation to an economic powerhouse. The novel distills its missing central character down to a series of warm, sometimes

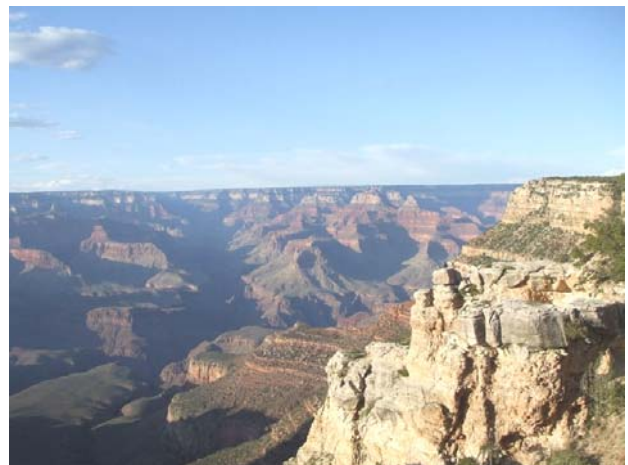

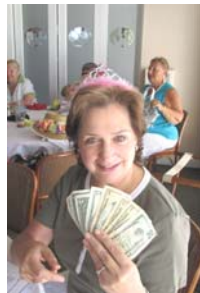


