



The Plan consists of three stages:

Stage 1 – Freedom

Stage 2 – Change

Stage 3 – Victory

At New Life Church we have adopted a simple focus for moving God's people into spiritual growth and maturity. It is called the New Life Plan, a spiritual formation and discipleship program.

In Stage 1 each member will be trained in the basics of the faith. We learn who Jesus is and what He came to do. What is salvation, and what does it mean to be born again? Is it necessary? Why?

We will learn about deliverance. Can a person really be delivered from bondages of any kind? What about chemical addictions? Sexual addictions? How about anger or depression? Can it happen immediately or does it take time? Are there really generational curses and bondages that are passed down in families, and can we be free from them? If so, how?

Each member will discover the life changing power of prayer, and learn how to pray to get results. We will put it to practice in our sessions and see first- hand how prayer works.

In Stage 1 we will also learn about how to study God's word and how to apply it. If you have ever struggled in reading and understanding scripture, this will be extremely helpful. Even if you've been a Christian for a long time and are familiar with the bible and how to read it, you will be surprised how much you will benefit as well.

Finally, we will examine the major non-Christian religions and cults. We will provide a comparative study of each one, including Jehovah's Witnesses (Watchtower Society), Mormonism (Latter-Day Saints), Islam (Including Nation of Islam) and Judaism (including its different branches), with their similarities and differences from biblical Christianity.

In Stage 2 our members will move to training step by step in how to grow spiritually. We will be introduced to the Holy Spirit and how He works. We will learn what faith is and how to grow in faith.





d. Prayer - Praying for fellowship, for power, and for others


Each member will discover the life changing power of prayer, and learn how to pray to get results. We will put it to practice in our sessions and see first-hand how prayer works.
