

## Report ready for first number in the show wearing:

the costume for the first number they perform and with: hair pulled back in a bun with a hairnet with gel and hairspray no bangs

> make-up at your discretion no nail polish no jewelry

Each additional costume should be brought to the show in its own PAPER SUERMARKET BAG labeled in LETTERING THAT IS LARGE, DARK, EASY TO READ FROM A DISTANCE IN THE DARKNESS BACKSTAGE



When you arrive for the recital take your child and all extra costumes (in their bags) to the tables set up at the end of the hall (to the right of the auditorium entrance). Please take your child's street shoes with you into the auditorium.

Performers are NOT allowed in auditorium during the show. Parents are not allowed backstage.

All dancers must remain until the finale. All performers will perform in the Finale.

Dancers ages 7 and under will remain on the stage after the finale. Parents should come up to the stage when the show is over to pick up the dancers. Their extra costumes will be lined up in the hallway at the back of the stage.

Note: The order of the recital is not the same as the order of the dress rehearsal. Please be sure your child comes dressed in the costume that will be worn first in the recital. The order of the numbers in the recital is:
