Appendix 1

Conditions for Certification:

- 1. The facility will develop, implement, document and maintain a Phytosanitary Management System (PMS) and a Pest Management Plan (PMP) that complies with the Clean Plants Domestic Phytosanitary Nursery Certification Program.
- 2. The facility must develop and maintain a Clean Plants Manual that describes the PMS and the PMP in place at the facility. The nursery's manual must be submitted to the Canadian Nursery Certification Institute (CNCI) for approval.
- 3. The facility will ensure that all certified plant material meets the requirements of the Clean Plants program.
- 4. The facility will pay all fees associated and applicable to the CNCI.
- 5. The facility will immediately notify CNCI if a regulated pest is found.
- 6. The facility will immediately stop shipping plants under Clean Plants if a regulated pest is found, or if the facility is suspended by the CNCI.
- 7. The facility will immediately cease the use of their Clean Plants stamp on all documents and cease to market material as certified if they are suspended from the Clean Plants program.
- 8. The facility will notify the CNCI within 14 days of any change in ownership of the facility.
- 9. The name and address of Clean Plants certified domestic production facilities will be listed on the CNCI website. When a facility is suspended from the Clean Plants program, the facility will be removed from the list of Certified Nurseries until remediations are completed as required by CNCI.
- 10. The facility assumes all liability, if any, arising from the movement and sale of plants from the facility which have been grown according to the Clean Plants program.
