Key Challenges

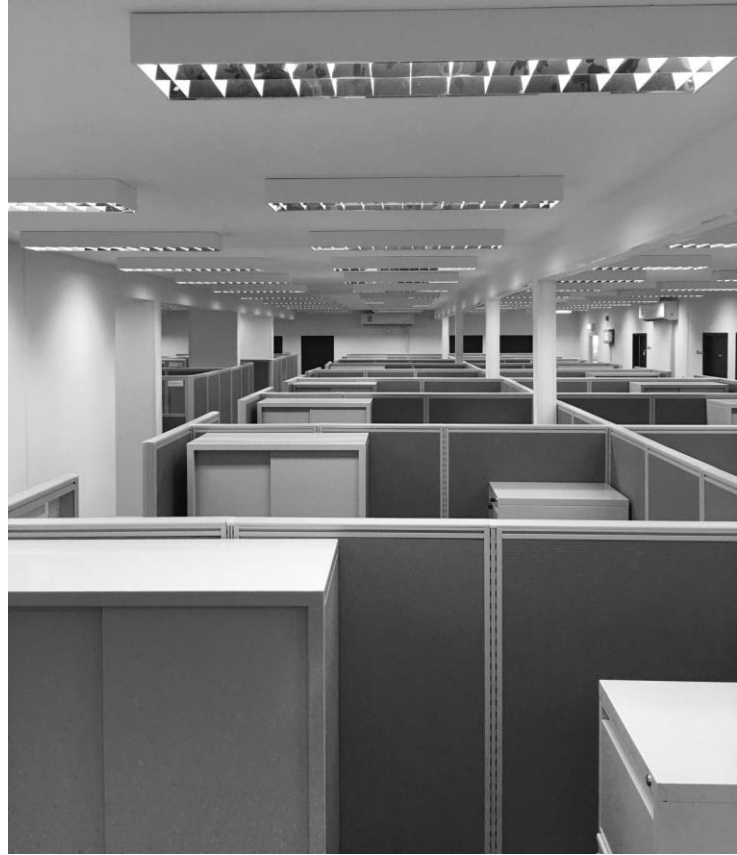
- ❖ Construction of Camp Site facilities on a deep remote desert location.
