

McKay, Kennett

Kennett H. (Mac) McKay, 70, of Sanford and formerly of Pigeon, died Friday, July 14, 2000, in the Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center, Ann Arbor, following a short illness. "Mac" McKay was born Feb. 28, 1930, in Lincoln Park to F. Harry and Bozena (Kennett) McKay. The family moved to Pigeon in 1937 when Mac's father bought Pigeon Lumber and Supply Co. Following military service in the Korean War, Mac graduated from Michigan State University. He worked at Pigeon Lumber until it was sold. He retired in 1999. Surviving are his daughter, Laurie Langschwager and her husband, Mark, of Bay City; two grandchildren, Scott and Katie; and a sister, Bonnie Kleinau of North Carolina.
