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- Enforcement of Deed Restrictions
  - Go to HOA website <u>www.westfieldvillage.org</u> to report violations that HOA can address
  - Homeowners are responsible for the compliance of the deed restrictions and that includes if you are renting your property. Any warnings or fines for violations will be issued to the owner of the property

- 158 Warnings issued, in addition to the following violations
  - 63 Grass/Weeds
  - 10 Trailers
  - 3 Boats/Jet Ski
  - 9 Trash
  - 6 Fence
  - 7 Parking
  - 2 RV

- Landscaping •
  - Creek bed cleared out and mowed to slow water pressure to keep from flooding

  - Roofs (HOA request to maintain shingles to match rest of subdivision)
