RULES FOR ART NELSON MEMORIAL YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Applications must be submitted on forms obtained from the Scholarship Committee
- 2. All applicants must have been an ARBA member and a member of Rocky Mountain High Shows, Inc. for at least one year prior to the application deadline.
- 3. Applicants must be under the age of 20 years when applying and either a senior in High School or a freshman in college, community college or vocational school.
- 4. An official transcript, from the High School or college they are attending must accompany all applications.
- 5. Application deadline each year will be April 15.
- 6. Only one scholarship will be awarded each year. New applicants will receive preference over a reapplication.
- 7. The scholarship award will be sent to the college in the name of the student.
- 8. Scholarship funds will be sent to the college by registered mail.
- 9. Funds from an awarded scholarship will be held in trust for one year. After that time funds will revert to the principle.
- 10. If there is no qualifying applicant, money will revert to the principle.
- 11. If scholarship recipient does not use the money within one year, scholarship would be awarded to second qualified applicant. They would have one year, after notification, to use funds.
- 12. Funds for scholarship will be derived from:
 - a. One half of the interest earned each year on all accounts. Interest figured from May 1 April 30.
 - b. Donations
 - c. Fund Raisers (Purina Weight Circles)
