This year, the theme for the season is 'Let Justice and Peace Flow'. Just like when the Prophet Amos shouted, 'Let justice roll on like a river, right-





Dear Parishioners,

September 24, 2023

Your St. Augustine's parish leaders and staff have taken action to address the impact homelessness has had on our church property and services to the needy.

The homeless situation and the resulting problems are a growing problem in the Moncton area. Church and school properties are particularly vulnerable as the homeless frequently seek these places out as they are familiar and comfortable with them.

Our church community is particularly vulnerable to homelessness as we have always been one of generosity and support of the needy. On our church property we have several organizations serving the needy: Ray of Hope Soup Kitchen; St. Vincent de Paul (provides clothing, and other household items); St. Augustine's Housing (provides housing to low-income seniors); and Rising Tide (provides housing to vulnerable women).

This spring and summer were particularly challenging with the homeless on the property. There have been more homeless on the property day and night, and they have stayed longer. There is more evidence of litter, drug use, and other risky behaviours. Parishioners and residents feel insecure and even unsafe.

Last week we had a meeting with 16 people representing church staff, Parish Council, Ray of Hope, St. Vincent de Paul, St. Augustine's Housing, Rising Tide, and community experts in homelessness from the RCMP and City of Moncton. Together, we discussed new approaches to a safety action plan to reduce trespassing and restore our property to a safe and welcoming place for everyone. Our St. Augustine's team will keep you updated as we prioritize the next steps and execute the action plan.

If you have any concerns or feedback on the homeless on the property, please contact Charlie Farrell, pastoral associate, or Kim Mahoney, secretary.

Your continued presence in church and voice matters to us as we continue our mission to serve the needy in our community in a safe and respectful manner.
