DESCRIPTION: Although the BP Cougar was an economical model it performed as well or better than higher end BP bows such as the Stallion, Javelina, Mustang and Pinto. I have owned several BP Cougars over the years, and every one has been a good shooter. Walnut and White Holly riser. This bow has been reconditioned. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. I added Maple tip overlays to beautify and strengthen the tips. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; There is a filled faint 3" stress line in the lower face limb that is in the riser section (does not extend into the working area of the limb). No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Comes with a rest and flipper rest as shown, and a new string.
