## Musician of the month



### Kelly Ray

Zanesville native Kelly Ray is reknowned as the area's rock n roll "bad boy," and frontman for 80s tribute band Jokers Wyld (https://m.facebook.com/80sMusicTribute). The singer/ songwriter was born into music. Kelly is the son of longtime local professional drummer Roger Ervin, who helped shape the local music scene throughout the 60s, 70s and most of the 80s. Music is in his blood. Kelly began playing guitar as a youth and later became the founding member of 80's tribute bands such as Trixie's Rage, Tin Pan Alley and now Jokers Wyld. It is fitting that Kelly and Jokers Wyld defied the Coronavirus shutdown, having performed one of the last shows in the area in March of 2020, and one of the first shows when live music was again permitted. In between, the band performed live on Facebook, including a spot on the nationally broadcast "Musicians Hangout," hosted by Maxine Maxwell and Toni Lucas (https://www.facebook.com/WaMusiciansHangout/). Kelly also holds the distinction of being the most-watched performer on "BarnTV," the YouTube channel for popular nightspot The Barn, which offers live music on a regular basis. BarnTV offers hundreds of videos from music performances at The Barn over the past seven years, nearly 200 more than the second most-watched video.. Kelly's solo acoustic rendition of "Little Boy Lost' has been watched 1,000 times (https://www.youtube. com/watch?v=MjgYVyDatKo). The song was written to raise awareness of addiction and recovery and was recorded at Paul's Jam @ The Barn in November 2019. More recently, Kelly serves as a mentor for young musicians. In part to support developing area talent, Kelly launched Wyld Records and Recording, an independent record label (https://m.facebook.com/WyldRecordsRecording/). "Wyld Records provides a means for newer musicians to be discovered," Ray said. "We offer personal service while keeping costs minimal."

#### Sebastian Jonathan James Longstreth Aka "CC" is a happy 9 year old born with Down syndrome and

some very complex medical issues. The first three years of his life, he was in and out of hospital.

Although limited to what he could do, his mother, Shannon never treated him like he was sick or different . She taught him through mimic, music and dance. After being on a ventilator for over 7 years, CC had became vent free. "It was a whole new world for us!" Says his mother. We finally got to try new things, like eating, and going to school. "Although he is non verbal, momma and CC decided to climb the social media latter with close to 700,000 followers across all socials. When they finally were free of their bubble, Covid hit and back in the bubble they

Mom started sharing the paintings on their socials and before they knew it, they were sold out and had a list of custom paintings. He does the back drops and mom does the sealing and they both decorate them.


