On behalf of our congregation, we welcome you. Finally, the mid-term elections are over and I for one am so thankful the campaigning is also over. Today is a very special service as we remember and celebrate Veterans' Day in our country. Life in the areas impacted by the recent hurricane continues and it is far from back to normal. Our Southern Baptist Disaster Relief remains on site with six feeding kitchens operational and a total of 593,154 meals served as of 2 November.

At the recommendation of the Deacons, our Nominating Committee will be recommending a special committee to investigate and develop a recommendation as to how we might best help.
