William Clark McCaslin, 90, of Port Austin, died Saturday, November 25, 2005, at the Huron County Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe. He was born October 28, 1915 in Cass City, son of the late Charles and Emma (Seeger) McCaslin. He married Eleanor Brzezinski on February 15, 1941 in Ubly. She preceded him in death on April 25, 2001. Clark graduated from Cass City High School in 1933 and worked as a barber in his father's barbershop for three years before moving to the Detroit area to work for Ford Motor Company. Clark and Eleanor moved to Port Austin from Southfield in the early 1970s upon retiring after 30 years from Ford. They spent their winters in Fort Myers, Florida until 1993. Clark was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force. He served in England during World War II. He was a member of the American Legion Frank Horetski Post No. 499 in Port Austin. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, golf, and playing cards.
