In recent years, 100% of senior University of Detroit Mercy engineers, with a 3-D printing background were offered full employment <u>before graduation</u>. While your choice of college is unlimited, if a winning student is accepted and enrolls with the University of Detroit Mercy and majors in 3-D printing, an additional \$1,000.00 will be forwarded to University of Detroit Mercy, on behalf of the student, upon proof of acceptance, to be used for typical qualifying expenses such as tuition, fees, books, program costs, meal plans, housing and/or transportation.

As the American Legion is a veteran's organization, we are asking that students are endorsed by a veteran. If you do not have a veteran family member or friend, you may be eligible for an interview with the Post 346 Commander for potential endorsement.

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The purpose of the Groves-Walker American Legion Post 346 Scholarship Program is to provide two deserving students (one boy and one girl) an opportunity to attend the college of their choice.

The base requirements for this scholarship are:

- 1) Be endorsed by an honorably discharged veteran of the US military.
- 2) Have at least a 3.0 grade point average and maintain it though graduation.
- 3) Plan to be a full-time student with a declared college major in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math.
- 4) Demonstrate leadership and a commitment to the community.

An essay must accompany your application, it should be 300-500 words.

Your essay must answer the following questions:

- 1) What is your program of study and why did you choose it as your major?
- 2) Do you have any 3-D printer experience or expectations?
- 3) Do you have any work related experience?
- 4) Do you perform any community service?
- 5) Have you received any honors or awards?
- 6) What are your career goals?
- 7) How would this scholarship assist you in meeting your goals?

- 7) Up to an additional 10 pages of supporting documentation, information and exhibits may be included.
