“Painting with Gouache”
Supply List

Gouache Paints

***(Please note: Do not buy Acryla Gouache. It is a new product that Holbein has come out with, and it’s gouache with acrylic in it. Not the same thing as regular gouache - properties are very different.)

- Preferably Holbein or Windsor Newton, as quality varies greatly between manufacturers.
- Colors needed: Permanent White (Windsor Newton), Cadmium Yellow Light, Permanent Yellow (or any other warmer yellow), Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Red, Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue (or any warmer blue). This is a basic six color pallet - three warm, three cool, and white.

Arches Watercolor Block, Hot Pressed, 11”x14” or larger

Watercolor Pallet - large white enamel pan is best. If you only have a plastic watercolor pallet with recessed wells, then also bring a large separate plate for color mixing.

Watercolor Brushes - flats and rounds are best. Any sizes - I will also have some for you to borrow.

Spray water bottle

Cups for water

Paper Towels

Remember! Make sure you get dark enough and light enough. And the complement of a color “grays” it down. If you only remember these two things, you’re off to a great start!!!!
