BISHOP'S LETTER FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE PARISH

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Peterborough Diocese,

Pope Francis often writes of the elderly with great affection and gratitude. He recognizes their important role in the Christian community and affirms them as the roots and memory of a people. In an address last August, he stated, "We must counter the harmful throw-away culture that marginalizes the elderly... the future of a people requires the encounter between young and old: the young people are the vitality of a people 'on the way,' and the elderly reinforce this vitality with memory and wisdom."


