

Immigration

1 Peter 2: 16 Act as free men, and do not use your freedom as a covering for evil, but use it as bondslaves of God. 17 Honor all people, love the brotherhood, fear God, honor the king (of Heaven).

The United States of America was the British Empire's most successful colony. Judeo-Christian values, tolerance, equality, private property and the rule of law were rooted in the foundation of the America colonies. The Declaration of Independence with these bold words by Thomas Jefferson, "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights; that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness. — That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed---", launched the United States of America as a nation based on free and independent thinking.

Individuals all over the world know what freedom means and they recognize the United States of America as the place where they can pursue their dreams. Freedom of religion and speech serve as the main draw of America for oppressed people of the world.

Millions of people have come year after year seeking independence from the tyranny of oppression with heavy burdens having given up or lost their entire familial past to do so.

Those people had no choice other than to assimilate into the fabric of the American society. Throughout our history waves of immigrants have created many problems as the potential for internal conflict and division along old national allegiances reached the boiling point. But the draw of becoming a part of the American society wove the tapestry of our diverse yet united people. Today, a large number of people are coming in waves from the same geographic areas fleeing in fear and economic hardship, without any desire to become Americans. They do not want to give up their old country and its ways and assimilate into our society. Dual citizenship is now the norm for 25-30 million people. Division into smaller and smaller groups with a common interest agitating for their own special rights has become the norm. For the first time foreign groups are seeking to overthrow our government by subversion and division. Special interest and foreign money lobby for legislation counter to the security and unity of America. Terror attacks on American soil have become common.

Former Supreme Court Justice Louis Brandeis, immigrant and first Jewish member of the Supreme Court, tried to set the standards for assimilation when he said that Americanization required that the immigrant adopt "the clothes, the manners and the customs generally prevailing here" and that he adopt "the English language as the common medium of speech."

But, Brandeis said, this is only part of it. "(W)e properly demand of the immigrant even more than this -- he must be brought into complete harmony with our ideals and aspirations and cooperate with us for their attainment. Only when this has been done will he possess the national consciousness of an American."

The real success story of America's melting pot has been the degree to which we have been able to assimilate the second generation -- the immigrant's children, who have grown up surrounded by American peers. And this is where the comparison to the crisis of 1900 gets systemic because the children of today's immigrants just will not have that many American peers. In 1900, America was a rapidly growing society in which most natives, like most immigrants, had many children.

Today as never before in America's history have so many immigrants arrived when compared to the size of the next generation of Americans that will be expected to assimilate their children. More than 25 percent of children under age 5 are Hispanic and the percentage is increasing dramatically with each passing year.

But it gets much worse, because we do not know the true number of "immigrants" we have today, since so many have crossed our borders illegally-- an important distinction with previous waves of immigrants that asked permission to enter and were accurately counted upon arrival. These people operate off the books using the freedom of our system but ignoring the laws of the land creating a sub culture without moral or legal control. The current estimate of the Census Bureau is around 15 million illegal immigrants. No provision has been made to actually account for the number of unknown foreign nationals within our country and identify the magnitude of the problem.

Census officials and academics underestimate the ingenuity, efficiency and the subterfuge of the communications network among immigrants and the within their own ranks to conceal the magnitude of the problem. Illegal immigrants work very hard to conceal their identities and successfully avoid being counted in some cases with the help of government officials. Sanctuary cities have become destination magnets for illegal immigrants.

Criminals in the immigration network refuse to identify themselves as such, and government officials even encourage them. Thus it is estimated that the Census Bureau has underestimated the population of illegal aliens in America by more than half, missing 10+ million people.

If that estimate is correct, then the current population of the foreign born in America is over 46 million -- 22.8% of the population of children under 5 in the country. This proportion could thus be nearly double what it was in 1910, the previous record. In addition, this estimate would mean that the foreign born now constitute 15.2% of the total population of the country -- more than at any time during the last 125 years. According to USA Today in September 2015, "The percentage of people living in the USA who were born outside the country reached 13.7% in 2015 and is projected to hit a record 14.9% in 2025, the report said. The country's previous high of 14.8% was set in 1890, when waves of Irish, Italian, Polish and other immigrants were coming to the USA." Do we have no choice other than to welcome them and assimilate them into the fabric of American life, what else can we do with 45+ million people?

When millions of people are coming to the United States each year—many of them from the same geographic area and without any desire to become Americans—how do we preserve and

perpetuate the “American identity”? By the American identity I mean those qualities that make us Americans, make our country the envy of the world and the beacon of hope for freedom loving people everywhere. If we lose those qualities, if we start to look like and act like people in the rest of the world, where will the next generation of political refugees seek asylum? Throughout history, America has absorbed waves of immigration and preserved a shared national identity by assimilating arrivals into the great “melting pot.” But many Americans have begun to wonder whether or not the “melting pot” is still melting—or if it has been replaced by the salad bowl of diversity which is dividing the country into enclaves like the Hatfield’s and McCoy’s, where clans and sects are even seeking to enforce their own law.

The equal protections clause is being ignored by Congress. Theodore Roosevelt understood the need for the assimilation of the “melting pot.” When He said: “The effort to keep our citizenship divided against itself by the use of the hyphen along the lines of national origin is certain to breed a spirit of bitterness and prejudice and dislike between great bodies of our citizens.” We have certainly reached that point today when a DNA test would be sought and needed by people to gain entrance into the hyphenated groups with the most privileges and immunities. Why is being American not enough anymore?

Theodore Roosevelt served as both Governor of New York and President of the United States during one of America’s largest and most famous waves of immigration.

“Let us say to the immigrant NOT that we hope he will learn English, but that he has GOT to learn it. Let the immigrant who will not learn it go back. He must be made to consider the interest of these United States or he should not stay here. He must be made to see that his opportunities in this country depend on it. He must be made to see that his opportunities in this country depend on knowing English and observing American standards. And employers cannot be permitted to regard him as an only industrial asset.”

There are many characteristics that set today’s immigration frenzy apart from others; many immigrants are now illegal entrants, most immigrants are now from the third world and entering a first world America, and many immigrants have embraced the idea that they need not assimilate into the American culture. In most cases today it is third generation of children born to them that assimilate into the American culture as the first and second generation are more isolated than ever before. Never before have the immigrants entered with the intent to subvert and destroy the nation. In addition, the simple total numbers matter when discussing issues such as population density and environmental burdens.

At the precise moment in history when the U.S. has abandoned any attempt to transmit Anglo-Saxon virtues to its own citizens, much less to immigrants, many people want to grant citizenship to hordes of immigrants who are here precisely because they are fleeing cultures that are utterly dysfunctional and ruinous for the humans who live in them.

The United States of America as a country has absorbed huge migrations of illiterate peasants in the past. But also a lot of them returned to their home countries. We got the good ones who sought to work and embrace the legal system that offered the greatest individual freedom in the history of the world and as a nation these common bonds are what hold us together. America was

not yet a welfare nation guaranteeing free medical care, room and board to everyone. We did not allow both legal and illegal immigrants the run of the land with the option to pay taxes and conform to our laws. We were a nation of laws and opportunities which created a desire in those arriving in our land to become Americans to raise the banner of the Stars and Stripes with pride in their new nation.

Old habits and old loyalties die hard; if there is no desire or reason to change them they will follow people unto death. As the numbers of the sects increase they are actually asking America to conform to their values their language, their religion, their law, and to their way of life. If an American found work in a foreign land he would be forced to conform to the laws of the country. It seems that only in America do people think freedom is absolute making anything they choose to do to be acceptable by the society at large.

As a nation we must define our immigration-assimilation policy by articulating three interconnected ideas: (1) welcoming immigrants and assimilating those immigrants into the mainstream of American civic life. (2.) Identifying those illegal aliens who are here only for economic reasons, training them to return to their homeland to influence the culture in a positive way. Show them respect find out why they would abandon the country of their birth and assist them in having a direct impact on the societies that are destroying the lives of so many people. We must identify the number of nations; the numbers of people represented from each nation, and develop a coordinated national policy for interaction with that country in all areas, socioeconomic, legal and through existing foreign aid program. People should return to their homeland with a positive view of their experience in America and the knowledge of how to improve their homeland. (3) The most difficult group is the one crossing multiple national borders to penetrate the United States of America with nefarious intent. They have a plan, the financial support and the will to do anything required to take down our government and our society.

But don't forget even illegal immigrants are individuals. You never feel wrong when you hurt other people only when you are the one being hurt does it feel wrong. The objective is not to hurt and destroy the individual but to bring them into the open, to give them the opportunity to completely embrace America and the notion of becoming an American. If that is not their desire we must determine why they are here, and make provisions to return to their home land if they are here for purely economic reason. They must be treated as spies or agents of clandestine operations if they are hiding, encouraging organized riots or individual acts of terrorism. There exists an international protocol for dealing with them.

Another part of the issue today is that immigrants and natives have very different birthrates. Not only are many more Americans today elderly and beyond childbearing age, but those who can bear children often don't. Birthrates are below replacement levels for most groups within the United States. The population of those descended from the native-born is thus declining. Today's immigrants, on the other hand, still have high birth rates. In 2004, native-born women between the ages of 15 and 44 had 56.7 births per 1000 women. Immigrant women of the same age had 83.7 births per 1000 women -- a rate 47.6% higher than the native born.

This staggering and unprecedented difference in fertility, encouraged by our state welfare

system, means that just as America is receiving masses of immigrants as great as any in her history, our ability to assimilate their children is at an all-time low.

Never before in America's history have this many immigrants arrived when compared to the size of the next generation of Americans that will be expected to assimilate their children and never have the arriving immigrants been more determined to stay religiously, socially, economically, and legally isolated with their own people. Many have even gone to the extent of honor killing, the act of maintaining religious purity by killing their own offspring.

If you compare the number of immigrants per year to the number of native born children under say the age of five for the last 100 years, it started to increase when abortion became legal and is now at an all-time high.

Keep in mind it is our aversion to children that is the problem, not immigrants' acceptance of them. Most liberal people seem to think that 1.3 million abortions per year is just the price we pay for living in a free and modern society but look at the effects on the future of America. What do you think 1,300,000 men and women per year born in the most successful, blessed society in the history of the world could accomplish? What have we lost?

In effect what we have is the convergence of two national problems abortion and illegal immigration. Which one is the most important? Which one will have the greatest impact on the future of the United States of America? One group of heirs we terminate and the other we isolate. In combination the result will be the total destruction of homeland America as she was known before Row v. Wade.

What are we to do? Lay aside the interpersonal malice and let moral excellent shown in love be your guide read the Bible. Love the lord your God and love your neighbor as yourself. Ask what would Jesus do? Grow beyond your self-righteous desires. Extend yourself be real about your views. Be real, be heart felt like your Father who gives you love.

Who is your neighbor? Help your neighbor. The man or unborn child who needs help fully understands who his neighbor is: anybody that can help. Do you have a struggle understanding love thy neighbor as thy self? Do you not know Jesus?
