Jump Start Summer INTERNSHIP is an opportunity for incoming 12th graders & class of 2021 graduates to participate in a workbased learning program and earn 1.0 Carnegie Credit & a **\$1,500 stipend!**

Internships are work-based activities where students work with an employer to learn about a particular occupation or industry in the following high-wage, high demand fields: **Health Sciences**, **Information Technology, Automotive, or Skill Crafts**. Students must currently possess an industry-based credential (IBC) and be willing to find an internship in that field.

EXAMPLES OF INTERNSHIP PLACEMENT

- Students may job shadow or be employed
- Student with a Medical Assistant or Patient Care Tech credential can work in a doctor's office, nursing home, or medical facility
- Student with a skill trade credential such as NCCER Carpentry can work in areas such as a cabinet shop, with a contractor, or in similar industry
- Student with an ADOBE or CompTIA certification can work for a graphic design company or IT department

Students *may not* work for a family-owned business

Details About the Internship Program:

- Program will last from May 28 July 16
- 15 students will be chosen to participate

Students selected to participate:

- Must provide their own reliable transportation
- Must have good school attendance
- Must be in an approved job shadow position and/or be employed by May 14th; letter from supervisor proving placement due once selected
- Must work an average of 20 hours each week
- Will attend a 2-hour class once a week to develop beneficial skills to succeed in the workplace
- Students who successfully complete the program by attending all classes, completing assignments, and work for 140 hours will earn a stipend of \$1,500 and 1.0 Carnegie Credit
