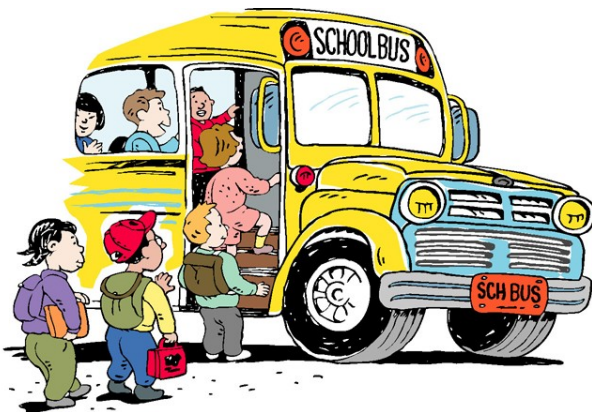


Program Highlights

The Younger Years (K - 2nd Grade)

Children this age need help reading directions for homework and completing homework. They are beginning to learn how to read on their own and enjoy reading with their parents or other adults. Children are starting to understand basic math problems, but may still need help in completing assignments. Children enjoy being with friends and are interested in rules and rituals of play.

The Older Years (3rd - 7th Grade)

Children this age can usually read and understand their homework without the help of an adult. They can read entire books with little or no help. Children are starting to understand more complex math concepts and may need some help with these homework assignments. Children this age enjoy large group activities such as board games and sports.
