SHARING GIFTS

POLICY

The Yellowknife Quilters should generally do at least one Sharing Gifts project each membership year.

DEFINITIONS

- Sharing Gifts is the name for projects the Yellowknife Quilters do as a group to support people or organizations that could benefit from some warmth and sharing.
- **Members** means members of Yellowknife Quilters.

AUTHORITY

- Each Sharing Gift project has a designated leader. This may be the Sharing Gifts coordinator or a volunteer member.
- Projects must be approved by the executive, either at a regular meeting or by email vote.

GUIDELINES

- Projects should benefit NWT people or organizations.
- Projects may be suggested by members or requested by outside groups. If suggested by member, the Sharing Gifts coordinator will confirm that the gift will be welcome.
- Where a donation is made to an organization for a raffle or auction, that will not be repeated the next year.
- Materials may be donated by members or purchased for a project, with executive approval.
- Quilting projects and sewing projects (like pillowcases, comfort pillows) will both be considered.
- Participation in each project will be offered to all members and is voluntary.
- An amount for Sharing Gifts will be included in the annual budget, although the budget may be increased if needed.
