DESCRIPTION: Locksley was a mid-range Ben Pearson bow line that was marketed mostly to England and other European countries in the 1960s. This Locksley Lion mofrl reminds me of a super-charged Pearson Cougar. It is more substantial than the Cougar, and featured tip overlays which were rarely added to lower-end bows. Green glass on the face, and red glass on the back. Comfortable pistol grip. No delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlay tips are in great condition. NO drilled holes. A few hairline stress lines; no crazing. No chips, dings or cracks. A few scratches and scuffs. This is a nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
